I have your memorandum of June 25, 2008 concerning the above. The memo consists largely of rehashing of prior incorrect statements and positions and semantical games. Under the circumstances, and given the considerable amount of time I have already spent on this issue, I do not believe it a productive use of my time to prepare a point-by-point response. Accordingly, in order to bring this matter to a close, the Firm is willing to adopt the approach you proposed, as an exception to its policy in this instance, by permitting a write off of the bill to and an agreement terminating the representation, whereupon the file will be forwarded to

For future reference, I reiterate for you that Firm policy does not provide for legal representation of partners' relatives free of charge. Moreover, other than basic and preliminary, informal advice that partners may provide one another from time to time, the only legal services the Firm will provide free of charge to partners (and, where applicable, their spouses) are simple will and estate plan services and services related to the purchase, sale or refinancing of a primary residence.
