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**DECLARATION OF MARC J. CARMEL IN SUPPORT OF CETERO'S APPLICATION
FOR ENTRY OF ORDER AUTHORIZING RETENTION AND EMPLOYMENT OF
PAUL HASTINGS LLP AS COUNSEL, NUNC PRO TUNC TO PETITION DATE**

Pursuant to Rule 2014(a) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedures (the "Bankruptcy Rules") and Rule 2014-1 of the Local Rules of Practice and Procedure for the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the "Local Rules"), I, Marc J. Carmel, declare that the following is true to the best of my knowledge, information, and belief:

1. I am an attorney admitted and in good standing to practice in the State of Illinois. My application for admission *pro hac vice* to the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware is pending before the Court.

2. I am Of Counsel of the law firm of Paul Hastings LLP ("Paul Hastings" or the "Firm"), located at 191 North Wacker Drive, Thirtieth Floor, Chicago, Illinois 60606, and I am duly authorized to make this Declaration on behalf of Paul Hastings. I make this Declaration in

support of the Application for Order, Pursuant to Bankruptcy Code Section 327(a) and 330, Authorizing Cetero to Retain and Employ Paul Hastings LLP as Counsel, *Nunc Pro Tunc* to the Petition Date (the "Application"), submitted by Contract Research Solutions, Inc. and its affiliated debtors as debtors in possession (collectively, "Cetero").² The facts set forth in this Declaration are based upon my personal knowledge, discussions with other Paul Hastings attorneys, and the Firm's client/matter records that were reviewed by me or other Paul Hastings attorneys acting under my supervision and direction. To the extent any information disclosed herein requires amendment or modification upon Paul Hastings' completion of further review or as additional information becomes available, a supplemental declaration will be submitted to the Court reflecting such amended or modified information.

3. Paul Hastings is well qualified to serve as Cetero's counsel in the Chapter 11 Cases. Paul Hastings is one of the largest law firms in the world, with a national and international practice, and with substantial experience in virtually all aspects of the law that may arise in the Chapter 11 Cases. Paul Hastings has several hundred attorneys and other employees located in offices around the World.

4. In particular, Paul Hastings has extensive bankruptcy and restructuring, corporate, employee benefits, environmental, finance, intellectual property, labor and employment, litigation, real estate, securities, and tax expertise. Paul Hastings' finance and restructuring group provides an array of services to assist financially distressed businesses and their creditors in maximizing values and ultimate recoveries in a broad range of challenging circumstances. The finance and restructuring group comprises approximately 70 attorneys. In roles ranging from debtor's counsel to committee counsel, Paul Hastings' lawyers have played a significant role in many of the largest and most complex cases under the Bankruptcy Code, including, among many others, the chapter 11 cases of NewPage Corporation, Allegiance Telecom, Inc.,

Dictaphone Corp., Six Flags, Inc., AbitibiBowater, Inc., Spansion, Inc., Lehman Brothers, Refco, Inc., WorldCom, Inc., Kmart Corporation, Adelphia Communications, Inc., Fruit of the Loom, and Enron Corp.

Paul Hastings' Disclosure Procedures

5. Paul Hastings has a large and diversified legal practice that encompasses the representation of many financial institutions and commercial corporations. In preparing this Declaration, I used a set of procedures (the "Firm Disclosure Procedures") developed by Paul Hastings to ensure compliance with the requirements of the Bankruptcy Code, the Bankruptcy Rules, and the Local Rules regarding the retention of professionals. Pursuant to the Firm Disclosure Procedures, I performed, or caused to be performed, the actions described below to identify Paul Hastings' connections to parties in interest in these proceedings.

6. In preparing this Declaration, pursuant to the Firm Disclosure Procedures, I submitted or caused to be submitted for review under our regularly updated conflicts check system the names of various parties in interest in the Chapter 11 Cases (collectively, the "Interested Parties"), as received from Cetero. A list of the categories of Interested Parties is set forth on Schedule 1 attached hereto. The results of our conflicts check were compiled and analyzed by Paul Hastings' attorneys acting under my supervision.

Paul Hastings' Connections With Interested Parties

7. To the best of my knowledge, based on the review procedures described above, Paul Hastings does not have any "connections" to the Interested Parties, except as described in this Declaration. Neither the term "connection," as used in Bankruptcy Rule 2014, nor the proper scope of a professional's search for a "connection" has been defined, and I am therefore uncertain what this Court may consider a "connection" requiring disclosure. Out of an abundance of caution, therefore, I am disclosing representations even though they are not, to my

understanding, disqualifying or problematic under either the Bankruptcy Code or applicable standards of professional ethics.

8. Neither I, nor any partner, of counsel, or associate of Paul Hastings, as far as I have been able to ascertain, has any connection with Cetero, its creditors, its attorneys and accountants, or any other Interested Party, except as otherwise set forth in this Declaration.

9. Based on its conflicts research, the Firm makes the following specific disclosures:

- (a) Attached hereto as Schedule 2 is a list of Interested Parties (or their affiliates) whom Paul Hastings currently represents and may in the future represent in matters unrelated to the Chapter 11 Cases. Attached hereto as Schedule 3 is a list of Interested Parties (or their affiliates) whom Paul Hastings has represented in the past in matters unrelated to the Chapter 11 Cases. Generally, it is Paul Hastings' policy to disclose clients or former clients in the capacity that they first appear in a conflicts search. For example, if a client already has been disclosed in this Declaration in one capacity (e.g., a customer), and the client or former client appears in a subsequent conflicts search in a different capacity (e.g., a trade creditor), Paul Hastings does not disclose the same client again in supplemental declarations, unless the circumstances are such in the later capacity that additional disclosure is required. Although Paul Hastings has represented, currently represents, and/or may continue to represent certain entities and individuals listed on Schedules 2 and 3, Paul Hastings will not represent any such entity or individual in the Chapter 11 Cases. Paul Hastings does not represent any entity other than Cetero in matters related to the Chapter 11 Cases.
- (b) To the best of my knowledge, none of the entities listed on Schedules 2 and 3 (and any affiliates thereof) represents more than one percent (1%) of Paul Hastings' annual revenues for the 12 months ending January 31, 2012, other than the following: Wells Fargo & Company (2.00%), General Electric Company (1.38%), AT&T (1.28%), and Nestle (1.12%), which is related to certain Interested Parties, such as Galderma Laboratories, L.P.
- (c) The Firm currently represents, and in the past has represented, KRG Capital Partners and certain of its affiliates (collectively, "KRG"), which jointly own a substantial equity interest in Cetero's ultimate "parent" company, Contract Research Solutions, Inc., on a variety of matters unrelated to the Chapter 11 Cases. The Firm represented KRG in its acquisition of debtor-in-possession, Diabetes and Glandular Disease Research Associates, Inc., and this matter was closed in April 2008. The Firm also represented KRG in its acquisition of debtor-in-possession, PRACS Institute, Ltd, and this matter was closed in April 2008. In addition, KRG is a lender to Cetero; however, it is not expected that this claim will receive any distribution in the Chapter 11 Cases. Except as disclosed herein, Paul Hastings' prior and current representation of KRG has been in matters unrelated to Paul Hastings' representation of Cetero in the Chapter 11 Cases, and Paul Hastings will not represent KRG in the Chapter 11 Cases. Young Conaway Stargatt & Taylor, LLP will advise Cetero with respect to any issues between

Cetero and KRG. Paul Hastings last invoiced KRG for work with respect to Cetero in January 2007.

- (d) The Firm represents the General Electric Company and certain of its affiliates (“GE”) in matters unrelated to the Chapter 11 Cases. GE is a participant in the prepetition first lien and second lien debt of Cetero. Freeport Financial LLC serves as U.S. first lien agent and second lien agent, and Bank of Montreal serves as Canadian first lien agent.
- (e) On behalf of Cetero, Jefferies & Co., Inc. (“Jefferies”) initiated a marketing effort for the potential sale of Cetero’s assets. As part of this marketing effort, Jefferies worked with Cetero to identify potential purchasers to whom it distributed certain information about Cetero. Cetero disclosed the names of the potential purchasers to Paul Hastings to enable Paul Hastings to run conflicts checks. As part of its conflicts results, Paul Hastings searched its conflicts database for potential parties-in-interest identified by Cetero. Paul Hastings entered the names of the potential purchasers into its client database to determine whether current or previous representations of the potential purchasers concerned matters related to Cetero or to the Chapter 11 Cases. Paul Hastings represents and has represented in the past certain potential purchasers in matters unrelated to the Chapter 11 Cases. The identities of the potential purchasers, however, are not being disclosed to protect the integrity of the marketing effort.
- (f) The Firm represented in the past certain of the debtors in possession in matters related to another debtor in possession, in the following circumstances:
 - (i) Allied Research International, Inc.—The Firm represented Contract Research Solutions, Inc. in its acquisition of this entity. This matter was closed in September 2008.
 - (ii) Allied Research International Inc.—The Firm represented Contract Research Solutions, Inc. in its acquisition of this entity. This matter was closed in September 2008.
 - (iii) Allied Research International India, LLC—The Firm represented Contract Research Solutions, Inc. in its acquisition of this entity. This matter was closed in September 2008.
 - (iv) BA Research International Holdings, LLC—The Firm represented Contract Research Solutions, Inc. in the acquisition of this entity. This matter was closed in January 2012.
 - (v) Contract Research Solutions, Inc.—The Firm represented Specialty Research, Inc. in its sale to Contract Research Solutions, Inc. This matter was closed in January 2012.
 - (vi) CRS Real Estate Holdings LLC—The Firm represented Contract Research Solutions, Inc. in a sale-leaseback matter involving this entity. This matter was closed in September 2008.

- (vii) Diabetes and Glandular Disease Research Associates, Inc. – The Firm represented Contract Research Solutions, Inc. in its acquisition of this entity. This matter was closed in March 2006.
- (viii) Gateway Medical Research, Inc.—The Firm represented Contract Research Solutions, Inc. in its acquisition of this entity. This matter was closed in January 2012.
- (g) From time to time, the Firm has referred work to other professionals retained or to be retained in the Chapter 11 Cases. Likewise, certain such professionals have referred work to the Firm. In matters unrelated to the Chapter 11 Cases, the Firm has worked with certain of Cetero’s other professionals.
- (h) Given the number of attorneys in the Firm’s various offices, several attorneys at Paul Hastings have professional, working, or social relationships with firms or professionals at firms that may be adverse to Cetero. In addition, several attorneys at Paul Hastings have spouses, parents, children, siblings, and other relatives who are attorneys at other law firms or companies. Also, certain attorneys at Paul Hastings may have spouses, parents, children, siblings, and other relatives who are employees of one or more of the Interested Parties. Paul Hastings has strict policies against disclosing confidential information to anyone outside of Paul Hastings, including spouses, parents, children, siblings, and other relatives.
- (i) The Firm has several hundred attorneys and other employees. It is possible that certain Firm attorneys or employees hold interests in mutual funds or other investment vehicles that may own interests in Cetero.
- (j) Certain insurance companies pay the legal bills of the Firm’s clients. Some of these insurance companies may be involved in the Chapter 11 Cases. None of these insurance companies, however, are Firm clients as a result of this situation.

10. Despite the efforts described above to identify and disclose Paul Hastings’ connections with parties in interest in the Chapter 11 Cases, because Paul Hastings is an international firm with several hundred attorneys in offices around the world, and because Cetero is a substantial enterprise with many creditor and other relationships, Paul Hastings is unable to state with certainty that every client representation or other connection has been disclosed. In this regard, if Paul Hastings discovers additional information that requires disclosure, Paul Hastings will file a supplemental disclosure with the Court.

11. To the best of my knowledge and belief, insofar as I have been able to ascertain after reasonable inquiry, neither I, nor Paul Hastings, nor any partner, of counsel, or associate thereof holds or represents an interest adverse to Cetero or its estates, and Paul Hastings is a

“disinterested person,” as defined in section 101(14) of the Bankruptcy Code and as required by section 327(a) of the Bankruptcy Code, because: (a) Paul Hastings has no connection with Cetero, its creditors, the United States Trustee (the “U.S. Trustee”), any person employed in the office of the U.S. Trustee or any other party with an actual or potential interest in the Chapter 11 Cases or their respective attorneys or accountants, except as set forth herein; (b) Paul Hastings is not a creditor, equity security holder, or insider of Cetero; (c) none of Paul Hastings’ attorneys is or was, within two years of the Petition Date, a director, officer, or employee of Cetero; and (d) Paul Hastings neither holds nor represents an interest materially adverse to Cetero, its estates, or any class of creditors or equity security holders, by reason of any direct or indirect relationship to, connection with, or interest in Cetero, or for any other reason. Accordingly, I believe that Paul Hastings is a “disinterested person,” as defined in section 101(14) of the Bankruptcy Code and as required by section 327(a) of the Bankruptcy Code.

Paul Hastings’ Rates, Advance Payment, And Billing Practices

12. It is Paul Hastings’ policy to charge its clients in all areas of practice for expenses incurred in connection with a client’s case. The expenses charged to clients include, but are not limited to, photocopying, witness fees, travel and lodging expenses, certain secretarial and other overtime expenses, filing and recording fees, long distance and other telephone charges, postage, vendor charges, express mail and messenger charges, expenses for “working meals,” and telecopier charges. Paul Hastings will charge Cetero for these expenses in a manner and at rates consistent with charges made generally to its other clients, subject to this Court’s approval of such expenses pursuant to sections 330 and 331 of the Bankruptcy Code, the Bankruptcy Rules, and the Local Rules as may from time to time be applicable, such procedures as may be fixed by order of this Court or the U.S. Trustee Guidelines, and consistent with the parties’ engagement letter. Paul Hastings believes that failure to charge these expenses would require the Firm to increase its current hourly rates.

13. Subject to the Court's approval, Paul Hastings intends to (a) charge for its legal services on an hourly basis in accordance with its ordinary and customary hourly rates in effect on the date services are rendered and (b) seek reimbursement of actual and necessary out-of-pocket expenses.³ Paul Hastings will maintain sufficiently detailed, contemporaneous records of time and any actual and necessary expenses incurred in connection with the rendering of the legal services described in the Application by category and nature of the services rendered.

14. Paul Hastings' hourly rates are set at a level designed to compensate it fairly for the work of its attorneys and paraprofessionals and to cover fixed and routine overhead expenses. I believe that these rates are reasonable and commensurate with the hourly rates of other firms of similar size and expertise.

15. Paul Hastings intends to charge Cetero for services rendered in the Chapter 11 Cases at Paul Hastings' normal hourly rates in effect at the time the services are rendered. Paul Hastings' current hourly rates in the United States, subject to change from time to time, are \$615 to \$1,125 for partners and counsel, \$345 to \$805 for associates, and \$180 to \$345 for paraprofessionals.

16. The following professionals are expected to have primary responsibility for providing services to Cetero: Christian M. Auty, Marc J. Carmel, Sung Ho Choi, Luc A. Despina, Louis R. Hernandez, John D. Kang, Amit Mehta, Catherine P. Patton, William J. Simpson, and Michelle E. Yetter. Additionally, from time to time, other Paul Hastings attorneys and paraprofessionals will render services to Cetero.

17. To reflect economic and other conditions, Paul Hastings revises its regular hourly rates periodically (including in January each year) and requests that, effective as of the date of

such revision, the rates be revised to the regular hourly rates that will be in effect at that time. Paul Hastings agrees to be compensated based on the same rates generally charged for services rendered in matters handled by Paul Hastings for its clients. Paul Hastings understands, acknowledges, and agrees that it shall be entitled to reimbursement only for actual and necessary expenses incurred in connection with its representation of, or services for, Cetero.

18. Paul Hastings is not a creditor of Cetero. Pursuant to Bankruptcy Code section 329(a), Paul Hastings submits that during the one-year period before the Petition Date, Paul Hastings received from Cetero approximately \$2,833,359.60 for services rendered and expenses incurred in representing Cetero.

19. Before the Petition Date, Paul Hastings received an advance payment to cover anticipated fees for the period through the Petition Date for all professional services performed and expenses incurred, including those relating to the Chapter 11 Cases. Paul Hastings has applied a portion of the advance payment to credit Cetero's account for Paul Hastings' estimated charges for professional services performed and expenses incurred through the Petition Date and has reduced the balance of the credit available to Cetero by the amount of such charges. The precise amount of such charges and expenses will be determined upon the final recording of all time and expense charges with respect to the period before the Petition Date, and the advance will be applied against such amount.

20. Postpetition, the Firm intends to apply funds from the advance payment and otherwise seek payment of compensation and reimbursement of expenses in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Bankruptcy Code, the Bankruptcy Rules, the Local Rules, the U.S. Trustee Guidelines, and any additional procedures that may be established by the Court in the Chapter 11 Cases. Paul Hastings has agreed to accept as compensation for its services in the Chapter 11 Cases the advance payment and such additional sums as may be allowed by this

Court, based upon the time spent and services rendered, the results achieved, the difficulties encountered, and other appropriate factors.

21. To the best of my knowledge, information, and belief, insofar as I have been able to ascertain after reasonable inquiry, neither I nor Paul Hastings, nor any partner, of counsel, or associate thereof, has received or been promised any compensation for legal services rendered or to be rendered in any capacity in connection with the Chapter 11 Cases, other than as permitted by the Bankruptcy Code. Paul Hastings has not agreed to share compensation received in connection with the Chapter 11 Cases with any other person, except as permitted by section 504(b) of the Bankruptcy Code and Bankruptcy Rule 2016(b) with regard to the sharing of compensation among Paul Hastings' partners, employees, and staff.

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To the best of my knowledge, I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
